1. Hearty welcome to one and all. We would like to thank you all for responding to our invitation and gracing this occasion. We are extremely happy to present to you the annual report of Holy Mary's School.  
The school started on 2<sup>nd</sup> Feb 1999. Thereafter we got NOC from Punjab Govt. and affiliation from CBSE.
2. Swami Vivekananda once said education is the manifestation of the perfection that is already in man. It is true that education aims at bringing out the inborn talents in children. Every child from birth inherits some talents and capabilities and this school aims at bringing out this talents and development of the personality of the students.

  - d) Under 14, Mansih Kumar got gold medal in Taekwondo championship in District level.
  - e) Under 17, Sukhman got gold medal in Taekwondo championship in district level.
  - f) Under 14, Kamaljot and Mankirat got gold medal in Karate in district level.
